Purchasing Ticket Only for Clients

When you book tickets be sure to inform your clients BEFORE booking of the following:


- Tickets are non-refundable
- Tickets are non-transferable
- You can always change dates but you may have an increase in payment required if that new dates ticket prices are more.

Please note when booking Disney Tickets:

- Always always check the park reservation calendar to ensure the parks are available for their travel dates!
- Prices change so you want to book your clients tickets as early as possible.
- When entering into TESS please use the date of PURCHASE vs travel dates since Disney pays at time of purchase on Ticket Only bookings.
- Disney World pays out commissions for ticket purchase 3 days and more. 1-2
 day day tickets are non-commissionable and solely up to you whether you
 wish to book them or not for your clients. Many agents do because it leads to
 future bookings but anything non commissionable does not warrant any
 planning services such as emails or help booking dining and park
 reservations.
- Disneyland pays out commissions for tickets purchases 2 days WITH Park Hopper and 3 days and more with or without Hopper. 1 day tickets are non-commissionable and solely up to you whether you wish to book them or not for your clients. Many agents do because it leads to future bookings but anything non commissionable does not warrant any planning services such as emails or help booking dining and park reservations.
- Disney will not show you your commission like booking a package. You must calculate it yourself. You can get your commission by taking the amount PRIOR to taxes and multiply by 8% (or whatever amount your tickets are worth which you can find on the DTA under the tab Training and Benefits and then Commissions.

Be sure to upsell them on anything they need. Memory Maker and Genie+ for example... it is much easier to add it upon purchase than to sit on hold a few hours and add it later 😌

First log in and then select under "Destinations and Ticket Options". See orange circle below.




Now click "Find Prices"



Choose the tickets you wish to purchase. Regular theme park tickets or specialty tickets for events. These options will change based on season.






Follow steps based on your clients needs to select everything they need. DO NOT select Florida Resident ticket unless they reside in Florida and have a valid Florida license because Disney will require it upon ticket pickup.

Once you have the tickets purchased. Reminder ages under 3 are FREE for all tickets including specialty tickets... Disney WILL NOT refund you if you purchase an unneeded ticket and YOU will be responsible for paying them back if we cannot get it credited.

Once you book you will notate the conformation number on their file, this is what you will input in CRM in order to get paid. See orange circle below.



Commission is based off of the PRE tax amount, so be sure to write down that amount on your file and then calculate your commission off that.



Once purchased please scroll down to the end of the confirmation page and select "Print your Will Call Sheet". Save this under their file because you will need to include this in their final folder... this is their ticket that the ticket kiosk will ask for. Please always also email this to the client because many times they forget their folders!
